**USAC RACERS – THIS IS A STAGE RACE. YOU MUST COMPLETE ALL THREE STAGES IN SEQUENCE. ALL RACERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR KNOWING AND UNDERSTANDING USAC RULES!**

In order to promote public safety for everyone, **support vehicles for all cyclists WILL be required to depart from the road race start in Evanston for the North Slope Road parking, pick up, and feed zone area NO LATER than 9:45 a.m.** Once the road race begins at 10 a.m., no support vehicles will be allowed on Highway 150.

At North Slope Road, 30 miles south of Evanston, **support vehicles will be directed into the North Slope Road parking area.** No support vehicles will be allowed to park along the side of Highway 150. No vehicle traffic will be allowed beyond the gate at North Slope Road, except as allowed by our Utah law enforcement partners.

**Only cyclists will be allowed beyond the gate on the highway to race to the snowline, turnaround, and finish at either Bear River Ranger Station or Evanston.** Cyclists who finish at Bear River Ranger Station will free peddle to North Slope Road to be picked up by their support team or a shuttle bus back to Evanston.

**There will ONLY be one feed zone this year at North Slope Road. Feeding ONLY after cyclists have turned around at the snowline.** The length of the feed zone will be extended south of the gate at North Slope Road.

**ON-SITE REGISTRATION.** Registration and race packet pickup Friday evening, June 17th from 6 – 8 p.m. at the Wyoming State Hospital on HWY 150, off Exit 5. Registration and race packet pickup Saturday, June 18th beginning at 7:00 a.m. at the Wyoming State Hospital. **REGISTRATION WILL CLOSE AT 9:30 A.M.**

**RULES.** All USAC rules apply. **KNOW THE USAC RULES.** ANSI approved helmets are required. Feeding only at North Slope Road feed zone after cyclists have turned around at the snowline. “Wheel in Wheel out.” **Please wear your helmet at all times when you are on your bike. NO EXCEPTIONS. Sleeveless jerseys are not allowed. No tri-bars for road race or criterium. No open-ended handle bars.**

**RACE NUMBERS.** Numbers will be provided. Please wear your number on the **RIGHT SIDE** of your jersey for the **ROAD RACE, TIME TRIAL, and CRITERIUM.**

**KING OF THE SNOWLINE.** A **15 second time bonus** will be awarded to the first male racer in each USAC group to reach the snowline. **Awards for KOS.**

**QUEEN OF THE SNOWLINE.** A **15 second time bonus** will be awarded to the first female racer in each USAC group to reach the snowline. **Awards for QOS.**

**TIME BONUSES AT FINISH.** Time bonuses will be awarded to the first three male and female racers in each USAC group to cross the finish line. **Time bonuses at finish are 15 seconds for 1<sup>st</sup>; 10 seconds for 2<sup>nd</sup>; and 5 seconds for 3<sup>rd</sup>.**

**Back to Bear River Ranger Station Finish Line** Total 47+/- miles  
 For Master 55+; USAC Jr. Men, USAC Women 4 and Master 35+, Jr. Women and Recreational Citizens. Cyclists who finish at Bear River Ranger Station will free peddle to North Slope Road to be picked up by their support team or a shuttle bus back to Evanston.

**Back to Wyoming State Hospital FINISH LINE** 80+/- miles  
 for USAC Pro Men, 1-5, Master 35-44(A/B), Master 45-54, USAC Pro Women, 1-3, Competitive Citizens and Tandem.

**At the City of Evanston boundary, a Police Officer will be positioned to direct vehicles into the northbound outside traffic lane. The inside traffic lane nearest the curb will be for racers ONLY. Stay to the right of the orange cones. Several street intersections will be barricaded to vehicle traffic. City Police Officers and Road Marshals will be positioned at street intersections open to vehicle traffic. Use extreme CAUTION at these locations. The stage at the finish line will be marked with race banners located along the side of the highway.**

**USAC race officials will be located on the canopied stage at the finish line. Once you cross the finish line, you will have approximately 500 feet to the Wyoming State Hospital entrance. Please turn right into this entrance.**

**A Support Station staffed by State Hospital volunteers will be available in the grassed area adjacent to the finish line. Water, Powerade, fruit.**

#### **PARKING**

Parking for spectators and official race vehicles will be in designated race parking areas at the Wyoming State Hospital. Turn into the State Hospital as directed by State Hospital Security Staff. Parking at the State Hospital is

approximately 600 to 700 feet from the finish line. **You may not park along the side of the entrance road into the State Hospital.**

#### **RACERS AND DRIVERS RESPONSIBILITIES**

Racers must follow all USAC rules and “Rules of the Road.” Stay to the **RIGHT** of the road and **ALLOW NON-RACE TRAFFIC TO PASS. PLEASE NO DRAFTING BEHIND VEHICLES. SUPPORT VEHICLES MUST LEAVE THE STATE HOSPITAL BY 9:45 A.M. SUPPORT VEHICLES WILL BE DIRECTED INTO THE NORTH SLOPE ROAD PARKING AREA. NO VEHICLE TRAFFIC WILL BE ALLOWED BEYOND THE GATE AT NORTH SLOPE ROAD.** Drivers supporting racers **MAY NOT** follow race groups. Support vehicles will be identified with the number of their racer. Feeding allowed **ONLY** at the North Slope Feed Zone. Please **DO NOT LITTER.**

#### **WHEEL IN WHEEL OUT**

This means that a racer who places a wheel in a lag vehicle can only use the wheel they put in. If you do not put a wheel in a lag vehicle, you may **NOT** use someone else’s wheel.

#### **LIVESTOCK AND WILDLIFE**

Watch for livestock such as cattle/sheep and wildlife including **deer, elk, and moose**, either on or crossing the highway.

#### **SIGNS**

Signs attached to mile posts will be located approximately every 10 miles on either side of the highway from and back to Evanston. There will be orange WYDOT bike signs and other signs that will read **CAUTION: BICYCLE ROAD RACE TODAY, SATURDAY, JUNE 18th.**

#### **SNOW AND TEMPERATURE ALONG THE MIRROR LAKE SCENIC BYWAY**

**WEATHER WATCH** Be prepared for rapidly changing weather conditions on the North Slope. Cold weather can lead to **hypothermia**. Bring appropriate clothing. The road may be wet and slippery near the snowline. **PLEASE, BE PREPARED!**

#### **BUS SERVICE**

**Shuttle Buses** will be available to return racers to Evanston from the North Slope Road parking lot back to the Wyoming State Hospital.

A sag vehicle will follow the last racing group to leave from the start line. Disabled racers will be transported back to Evanston.

30 SECOND INTERVALS  
(Does not include citizen racers)**

(1) USAC Junior Men; (2) USAC Master 55+; (3) USAC Women 4 & Master 35+; (4) USAC Junior Women; (5) USAC Pro Women, 1, 2, 3;

**5-minute break**

(6) USAC Men 5; (7) USAC Men 4; (8) USAC Master 45-54; (9) USAC Master 35-44(A/B); (10) USAC Men 3; and (11) USAC Pro Men, 1, 2.

The start of the Time Trial is 1.3 miles south of KFC/Taco Bell on Yellow Creek Road. Look for the School District bus barn on the right hand side of the road as you are traveling south. You must park in the Bus Barn parking lot, not on the road.

Racers will ride 5 miles south along Yellow Creek Road turning around at the orange cone in the center of the road and back 5 miles to the finish. A Uinta County Deputy Sheriff will be positioned at the 5-mile turnaround. The finish line will be located on the opposite side of the road from the start. **WHEN YOU HAVE CROSSED THE FINISH LINE, DO NOT GATHER ON THE ROAD.** Please gather in the Bus Barn parking lot. A City Police Officer will be at the start/finish area to ensure traffic safety. An ambulance will be at the start/finish.

Yellow Creek Road is an open road. Property owners along the road may be traveling the road on their way to church, town or some other activity. Ride to the side of the road and be alert for vehicles entering the road from driveways. This road accesses a natural gas processing facility. On Sunday morning, there may be semi-truck tanker traffic; and/or plant shift change traffic traveling the road. **PLEASE PAY ATTENTION.** Watch for bumps, rough areas, or potholes in the road. Volunteer Road Marshals will be positioned along the road and at the 5-mile turnaround for traffic safety. Be alert, cautious, and courteous to adjacent landowners. There will be porta-potties at the Time Trial start.

**The first three racers to finish the final lap for the USAC Pro Men, 1, 2 will receive time bonuses as follows: 15 seconds-1<sup>st</sup>; 10 seconds-2<sup>nd</sup>; 5 seconds-3<sup>rd</sup>.**

This is a 1.3 mile closed course. The first left turn after the start begins a 6-block climb, **The Cook-Sanders Associates & The Spence Law Firm Hill**. A series of turns, **The Bootworks Curves** follow to 7<sup>th</sup> Street which is the **Evanston Emergency Physicians and KEVA Downhill** with a left taken at Main Street for **Domino's Pizza and Grouchy Mark Productions Sprint** back to the start. Alleys will be barricaded to vehicle traffic.

**Volunteer Road Marshals will be stationed at ALL CROSS STREETS for traffic control. However, PLEASE BE ALERT FOR CROSS TRAFFIC OR THE POSSIBILITY OF VEHICLES MISTAKENLY ENTERING THE COURSE. A warm-up prior to the start of each heat is allowed.**

There will be porta-potties in the 1<sup>st</sup> Bank parking lot at the corner of 10<sup>th</sup> & Main Street. **Be downtown early, well before your start. Start times are approximate.**

## **FINAL DO'S AND DON'TS**

### **RULES OF THE ROAD/LAW ENFORCEMENT SUPPORT**

Remember to stay to the right of the road and avoid bunching up when traveling along Highway 150. The "Two Abreast" rule applies for all racers.

**RACER SUPPORT VEHICLES WILL BE REQUIRED TO TURN INTO THE NORTH SLOPE ROAD PARKING LOT**

### **RACER SUPPORT CREWS MAY NOT FOLLOW RACERS**

Use caution when passing racers or highway traffic. **IF YOU FOLLOW YOUR RACER AND ARE IDENTIFIED BY RACE OFFICIALS, THE RACER WILL BE DISQUALIFIED.** If you pass in an unauthorized area, you risk a ticket from the Highway Patrol. Please help us keep our law enforcement officers happy.

**Please obey all traffic signs and traffic lights while warming up on your bike in Evanston. Bicyclists must follow the same Rules of the Road as motorists.**

**Please park only in designated race parking areas at the Wyoming State Hospital.**

**Please do not toss your water bottle into the forest. Race volunteers have to find and pick up all water bottles. Please make our job easier by dropping your water bottle just off the shoulder of the highway.**

**Remember to ride no more than two abreast in Wyoming, or you risk a citation from the Wyoming Highway Patrol.**
